Local overnight accommodations

Facility details

The Fifth Maine has a kitchen, dining room, wrap around porch, main hall, and restrooms, and is handicap accessible. Rugged paths through perennial gardens overlook the ocean. The building is equipped with Wifi.

The venue is available for events June-October. During museum opening hours, 11am-4pm, events will be held in the private kitchen/dining room. After hour events, 4pm-10pm can be held anywhere in the facility. We offer a full facility buyout for all-day private functions just once a month, so contact us early to secure a date.

Events in the kitchen/dining room are limited to 75 people. Events in the porch and main hall are limited to 100 people.

How to get there

Peaks Island is a twenty-minute boat ride from Portland, with ferries departing almost every hour from Casco Bay Lines.

Most guests prefer the ten-minute walk from the boat landing to the Fifth Maine. For those who don’t, the island taxi greets every boat and there are golf-cart rentals available near the dock.
