About the Fifth Maine Museum

The Fifth Maine Regiment Memorial Hall was built in 1888 by the veterans of the Fifth Maine Volunteer Regiment as a memorial and reunion hall. The veterans created a quiet, almost sacred space where they gathered, reminisced, and drew comfort from each other. Ongoing restoration work has brought the building back to its former glory. This architectural gem is now on the National Register of Historic Places.
